The Board of Commissioners has sent a "Letter of Consistency" with the 2001 Monroe County Solid Waste Plan to Republic Services for a vertical expansion at the Vienna Junction Landfill. This is a part of their application to the MDEQ for their proposed expansion. The expansion is only vertical over old portions of the landfill. It is expected to add an additional 6-8 years to the facility. The final approval will come from the MDEQ.

Once I receive some final invoices I will be able to provide you with some tonnage and participation information for the 2014 events if you would like that for next month please let me know. I will also have a new version of the RecycleNOW newsletter. We are moving the collection site at the Monroe Township Hall. The new site will start in February - more to come.
