

ROAD MILLAGE AND DUST CONTROL PROPOSITION

Shall the Township of Ash, Monroe County, Michigan, impose an increase of up to One (1) mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000.00 of taxable valuation upon real and personal property in the Township) in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution of 1963, as Amended, for a period of five (5) years (2017 through 2022 inclusive) for the purpose of maintenance, repair, improvement and dust control of public roads, bridges and public right-of-ways within the Township? This levy would provide estimated revenue to the Township of \$268,173 in the first year the millage is levied. This is a new millage.
