
WHEREAS, First District Court magistrates have been authorized to arraign on Personal Protection Orders on behalf of the Circuit Court and,

WHEREAS, First District Court magistrates are routinely-paid forty dollars (\$40.00) overtime pay for one or more magisterial matters handled on week-ends or nights, including arraignment on Personal Protection Orders,

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that the overtime slips for arraignments on Personal Protection Orders shall be signed by the Magistrate and by the Chief Circuit Court Judge and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that such overtime slips shall be submitted to the Monroe County Auditor's for payment out of the budget for Circuit Court, and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that internal guidelines issued by the Chief Judges shall be followed by the magistrates for arraigning on Personal Protection Orders, including issuance of orders of "no contact" to the defendant at time of arraignment and the setting of the defendant's appearance before the Circuit Court judge assigned to the case on the date and time previously approved by that judge.
