WAIVER OF JURISDICTION OVER CIVIL INFRACTIONS COMMITTED BY JUVENILES

IT IS ORDERED:


Pursuant to MCR 8.112(B), MCL 712A.2E, and MCL 600.8379(1), the 38th Circuit Court and the 1st District Court enter into the following agreement:

1. The circuit court waives jurisdiction over all civil infractions alleged to have been committed by juveniles within the geographic jurisdiction of the district court.
2. Upon execution of this agreement, the district court has jurisdiction over the juvenile in the same manner as if an adult had committed the civil infraction.
3. The assessment and distribution of fines and costs shall be as if an adult had committed the civil infraction

Copies of the administrative order shall be provided to all affected law enforcement agencies. Any modifications are subject to approval by the State Court Administrative Office.


