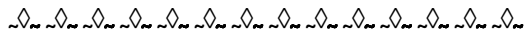


Role of the Monroe County Commission on Aging

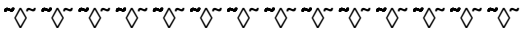

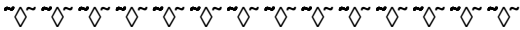

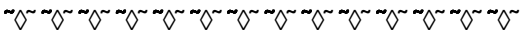
The Monroe County Commission on Aging Mission Statement
