Chairman Martin Kaufman called the meeting to order at 1:03 p.m.

**Member's Present:** Noel Dentner, Nancy Hamman, Paul Iacoangeli, Aleta Jackson, Martin Kaufman, Michael Pasko, Richard Springstead, and Loyd Sype.

Chairman Martin Kaufman led the Pledge of Allegiance and silent prayer.

### **Approval of the Agenda:**

Richard Springstead motioned to approve the July 12, 2005 agenda as presented. Supported by Aleta Jackson. **Motion carried.**

The following Budget Hearings were held:

### **Berlin Seniors:**

Margaret Springstead presenting- The Berlin Seniors requested \$11,790 for calendar year 2006. This is a 17% increase over fiscal year 2005. They have an 11% increase in membership and a 5% increase in meals from last year.

### **Petersburg-Summerfield Seniors:**

Pat Bundy and Donna Turner presenting-The Petersburg-Summerfield Seniors requested \$1,589 for calendar year 2006. This is no change from the current funding year.

### **Deaf & Hearing Impaired Services:**

Linda Booth presenting- The Deaf & Hearing Impaired Services is requested \$22,530 for fiscal year 2006. This is a 1% increase from their current fiscal year. They have a 10% increase in seniors served over the same period last year.

### **Frenchtown Senior Citizens Center:**

Barbara Mazur and Joseph Hess presenting- The Frenchtown Senior Center requested \$173,164 for calendar year 2006. That is a 3% increase from the current 2005 funding. The increase would cover the increased cost of utilities from the expansion.

### **Foster Grandparents Program:**

Bonnie Nelson presenting- The Foster Grandparents Program requested \$17,666 for fiscal year 2006. This is no change from fiscal year 2005.

Motion to adjourn by Richard Springstead, supported by Aleta Jackson. **Motion carried.** Meeting adjourned at 2:58 p.m.
