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### In-Home Services: Temporary Ramp Program

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**Service Name: Temporary Ramp Program**

**Service Definition:** Provision of temporary external ramp system to eligible senior where an agreed upon monthly rental fee is paid.

**Unit of Service:** One ramp

**Contract Type:** Fee for Service

#### Minimum Requirements:

1. Programs may subcontract with private companies that provide specific services.
2. Fee-for-Service and private pay options for seniors are recommended.
3. Service providers must have a system for documenting clients served, and client service satisfaction, which shall be available for review during the COA programmatic assessment.
4. Each program shall provide assistive ramps and offer explanation and demonstration on usage to the client.
5. The opportunity to meet with a Resource Advocate shall be offered if other needs are identified within the home.

6. Each program must maintain a record of homes adapted, including date of referral, date work completed, tasks performed, materials used, cost and sources of payment.
7. All safety devices installed must at a minimum conform to local building codes and meet UL safety standards.
8. Funds maybe used to purchase materials and labor to complete the ramp tasks.
9. Individuals who fail to make alternative payment arrangements or who fail to pay monthly rent agreement are subject to ramp removal.
10. All ramps are the property of Monroe County.
11. Programs must service the Monroe County Area.
12. Programs must serve residents age 60 and older.
