## Health Promotion & Disease Prevention

### Nursing

- Health education for individuals, families, and groups

### Diabetes Education for Seniors

- Individualized and group instruction in diet, medication, and lifestyle changes

### Hearing & Vision

- Hearing and vision testing for pre-school and school-age children
- Early hearing and vision testing for infants and children up to age three

## Public Health Emergency Preparedness

### Outreach & Education

- Presentations and educational materials
- Informational boards available for temporary display

### Planning & Response

- Disaster planning for public health emergencies
- Emergency preparedness exercise development and implementation
- Represents Monroe County in regional and state public health emergency planning

 = Appointment needed

## Clinic Services

### Dental

- Services include dental exams, extractions, x-rays, fillings, and cleanings

**Eligibility:** Children under 21 years of age and enrolled in Michigan Delta Dental Healthy Kids or Medicaid

### Family Planning

- Education, counseling, physical exams, and birth control supplies
- Medicaid and Plan First enrollment
- Call for clinic hours

### Immunizations

- Routine childhood immunizations and influenza vaccine
- Call for clinic hours

**Eligibility:** Varies, call or stop by to ask

### Sexually Transmitted Disease

- Infection testing, diagnosis, treatment, and education for sexually transmitted disease
- Call for clinic hours

### Communicable Disease

- Testing, prevention, treatment, education, and follow-up for contagious disease such as tuberculosis and food borne illness

## Clinic Services

### Other Clinic Services

- Blood pressure check
- Administration of shots ordered by a doctor
- Pregnancy testing
- Head lice check/treatment
- Call for clinic hours



## Maternal & Child Services

### MI Child/Healthy Kids Enrollment

- MI Child and Healthy Kids are health insurance programs
- Call for enrollment

**Eligibility for MI Child:** Children under 19 with no other insurance and family income is within guidelines

**Eligibility for Healthy Kids:** Pregnant women and children under 19 with no other insurance and family income is within guidelines

### Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Program (CLPPP)

- Lead poisoning prevention education, outreach, and follow-up for children by a public health nurse
- Call for more information

## Maternal & Child Services

### Special Supplemental Food Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC)

- Food and eating assessment, education, and counseling, coupons for healthy foods, referral, breastfeeding support, and lead testing

**Eligibility:** Pregnant, breastfeeding, and post-partum women, infants, and children up to age five

### Maternal Infant Health Program (MIHP)

- Home visits and coordination of services by a nurse, social worker, and/or dietician
- Education on labor, delivery, nutrition, smoking cessation, immunizations, and child growth and development



**Eligibility:** Medicaid eligible. For pregnant women, moms with babies less than 2 months old, and infants up to one year old and their families who need assistance

### Children's Special Health Care Services (CSHCS)

- Assistance for families in paying for their child's special need and coordination of services

**Eligibility:** Children under 21 years of age with special health care needs

## Environmental Health

### Food Service Inspections

- Inspection of restaurants, banquet halls, temporary food events, schools, and churches

### Water Quality Management

- Well water sample collection and analysis, well construction and permits, groundwater contamination site monitoring, and bathing beach monitoring

### Community Health & Safety

- Inspection of campgrounds, public swimming pools, child daycares, foster homes, and tattoo operations
- Mosquito surveillance
- Radon gas awareness
- Public health nuisance investigations



### Sewage Management

- Residential and commercial on-site sewage treatment and disposal inspection and permits

### Solid Waste Management

- Disposal of tires, cell phones, yard waste, agriculture chemicals, household hazardous waste, and electronic waste
