WAIVER OF JURISDICTION OVER CIVIL INFRACTIONS COMMITTED BY JUVENILES

IT IS ORDERED:

Pursuant to MCR 8.112(B), MCL 712A.2e, and MCL 600.8379(1), the 38th Judicial Circuit Court and the 1st District Court enter into the following agreement:

1. The 38th Circuit Court waives jurisdiction over civil infractions alleged to have been committed by juveniles within the geographic jurisdiction of the 1st District Court, **with the following exclusions:**

- a. MCL 436.1703(1)(a) Purchase, consumption or possession of alcoholic liquor by a minor;
- b. MCL 722.642(3)(a - c) Purchase, possess or use a vapor product or alternative nicotine product by a minor; and
- c. MCL 333.27965 Sec. 15 (3) A person under 21 years of age who possesses not more than 2.5 ounces of marihuana


2. Upon execution of this agreement, the 1st District court has jurisdiction over the juvenile in the same manner as if an adult had committed the civil infraction.

3. The assessment and distribution of fines and costs shall be as if an adult had committed the civil infraction.

Copies of this administrative order shall be provided to all affected law enforcement agencies. Any modifications are subject to approval by the State Court Administrative Office.
