APPOINTMENT OF MAGISTRATE

In accordance with Administrative Order 2009-6, effective January 1, 2010, and MCL 600.8501 and 600.8503, and upon approval of the State Court Administrative Office (SCAO),

IT IS ORDERED:

1. The judges of the 1st District Court appoint **Tod C. O'Lone** as magistrate with the approval of Monroe County. The magistrate's contact information is:

It is the responsibility of the magistrate to notify the State Court Administrative Office of changes in the individual's contact information during the course of the appointment.

2. **Tod C. O'Lone:**
 - a. Is a registered elector in the county of Monroe.
 - b. Will serve at the pleasure of the chief judge of the district court.
 - c. Will take the constitutional oath of office.
 - d. Has filed a performance bond in the amount of \$50,000 with the Monroe County treasurer and chief judge.

3. Magistrate **Tod C. O'Lone** is authorized to perform the following duties:
- a. Issue search warrants under general authorization. [MCL 600.8511(g)]
 - b. Issue warrants for the arrest of persons upon written authorization of the prosecuting or municipal attorney and set pre-arraignment bonds. Written authorization is not required for vehicle law or ordinance violations within the jurisdiction of the magistrate, if a police officer issued a traffic citation in accordance with MCL 257.728 and the defendant failed to appear. [MCL 600.8511(e)]
 - c. Fix bail and accept bond in all criminal cases. [MCL 600.8511(f)] Set bond and order the defendant to appear before the circuit court in the county for a hearing when the person has been arrested for violation of a personal protection order and the circuit court judge will not be present or available within 24 hours after an arrest. [MCL 764.15b(3)]
